The thirteen Senate bills dealing with education survived the Thursday, March 13th, deadline for general bills to be taken up on the Senate floor. SB 2351, dealing with the Mississippi Activities Association, has been held on a motion to reconsider.

Tuesday, March 31, 2020: Deadline for committees to report general bills and constitutional amendments originating in the other house
