The second week of the Legislative session was busy in the Senate. Committees started meeting to get organized for the year. The Senate Education Committee elected Senator Nicole Akins Boyd, District 9, as their committee secretary.

The Senate Appropriations committee passed SB 2001, the teacher pay raise bill. It now goes to the Senate Education Committee.

The Senate passed HB 1 which fully funds the teacher pay raise that was passed last session. The bill now goes to the Governor for his signature.

On the House side, the Speaker plans on announcing committee assignments next week. Once the assignments are made, the House committees will start taking up bills.
