<a href="#">SB2050</a>	School enrollment; allow for children with documentation of a parent's pending military relocation to the state. <b>Passed House Education Committee</b>
<a href="#">SB2447</a>	Career and technical grants to schools for qualified students; provide for. <b>Passed House Education and Appropriations Committees</b>
<a href="#">SB2449</a>	Education of students in juvenile detention facilities; define responsibility of home school district. <b>Passed House Education and Appropriations Committees</b>
<a href="#">SB2505</a>	Teacher Forgivable Loan Program; available to nontraditional licensed teachers under certain conditions. <b>Died</b>
<a href="#">SB2625</a>	Mississippi School of the Arts; provide for administration and clarify employee hiring procedures. <b>Passed House Education and Appropriations Committees</b>
<a href="#">SB2675</a>	Education Scholarship Account (ESA) program; revise. <b>Died</b>
<a href="#">SB2685</a>	Comprehensive eye examination for students prior to enrollment; require. <b>Died</b>
<a href="#">SB2770</a>	Teachers' salaries; provide for \$1,000.00 increase phased in over two years. <b>Passed House Education and Appropriations Committees</b>
<a href="#">SB2928</a>	Energy High School Academy; authorize Vicksburg-Warren and Claiborne school districts to enter into partnership. <b>Passed House Education and Appropriations Committees</b>
