

## House Education Bills 3/29/2019

<a href="#">HB 150</a>	Mississippi Dyslexia Forgivable Loan Program; clarify type of service committee to qualify for. <b>Sent to the Governor</b>
<a href="#">HB 572</a>	Educator use of personal leave; authorize use of by employees on certain days in the event of death or funeral of an immediate family member. <b>Signed by the Governor 3/15</b>
<a href="#">HB 578</a>	Teacher and administrator licenses; clarify grounds for disciplinary action and reinstatement. <b>Sent to the Governor</b>
<a href="#">HB 654</a>	County school board trustees; require runoff election if no candidate receives majority of votes cast. <b>Signed by the Governor 3/15</b>
<a href="#">HB1182</a>	Corporal punishment; prohibit use of in public schools to discipline a student with a disability. <b>Signed by the Governor 3/21</b>
<a href="#">HB1247</a>	Community college districts' boards of trustees; remove requirement for automatic appointment of county superintendent of education to serve on. <b>Sent to the Governor</b>
<a href="#">HB1283</a>	The "Mississippi School Safety Act of 2019"; enact. <b>Signed by the Governor 3/29</b>
<a href="#">HB1322</a>	Eye examinations; SBE to require all children six and younger to have comprehensive face-to-face before enrolling in public school for first time. <b>Signed by the Governor 3/15</b>
<a href="#">HB1456</a>	Ad valorem tax; revise certain provisions regarding the determination of true value of land used for agricultural purposes. <b>Died</b>

## Senate Education Bills 3/22/2019

<a href="#">SB2050</a>	School enrollment; allow for children with documentation of a parent's pending military relocation to the state. <b>Due from Governor by 3/25</b>
<a href="#">SB2447</a>	Career and technical grants to schools for qualified students; provide for. <b>Due from Governor by 4/1</b>
<a href="#">SB2449</a>	Education of students in juvenile detention facilities; define responsibility of home school district. <b>Due from Governor by 4/1</b>
<a href="#">SB2625</a>	Mississippi School of the Arts; provide for administration and clarify employee hiring procedures. <b>Due from Governor by 4/1</b>
<a href="#">SB2770</a>	Teachers' salaries; provide for \$1,000.00 increase phased in over two years. <b>Sent to the Governor</b>
<a href="#">SB2928</a>	Energy High School Academy; authorize Vicksburg-Warren and Claiborne school districts to enter into partnership. <b>Sent to the Governor</b>
