The Senate unanimously passed SB 2001, the teacher pay raise bill, with all members of the Senate listed as coauthors. The bill now goes to the House for committee assignment.

The House Education Committee elected Representative Timmy Ladner, District 93, as committee secretary.

New Legislative Deadlines

Wednesday, February 12, 2020	Deadline for making request for general bills and constitutional amendments to be drafted
Monday, February 17, 2020	Deadline for introduction of general bills and constitutional amendments
Tuesday, March 3, 2020	Deadline for committees to report general bills and constitutional amendments originating in their own House
Thursday, March 12, 2020	Deadline for original floor action on general bills and constitutional amendments originating in their own House
