HB 150	Mississippi Dyslexia Forgivable Loan Program; clarify type of service committee to qualify for. Due from Governor 4/19
HB 572	Educator use of personal leave; authorize use of by employees on certain days in the event of death or funeral of an immediate family member. Signed by the Governor 3/15
HB 578	Teacher and administrator licenses; clarify grounds for disciplinary action and reinstatement. Due from Governor 4/19
HB 654	County school board trustees; require runoff election if no candidate receives majority of votes cast. Signed by the Governor 3/15
HB1182	Corporal punishment; prohibit use of in public schools to discipline a student with a disability. Signed by the Governor 3/21
HB1247	Community college districts' boards of trustees; remove requirement for automatic appointment of county superintendent of education to serve on. Due from Governor 4/19
HB1283	The "Mississippi School Safety Act of 2019"; enact. Signed by the Governor 3/29
HB1322	Eye examinations; SBE to require all children six and younger to have comprehensive face-to-face before enrolling in public school for first time. Signed by the Governor 3/15

SB2449	Education of students in juvenile detention facilities; define responsibility of home school district. Signed by the Governor 3/29
SB2625	Mississippi School of the Arts; provide for administration and clarify employee hiring procedures. Signed by the Governor 3/29
SB2770	Teachers' salaries; provide for \$1,000.00 increase phased in over two years. <i>This bill was amended, and will give teachers and assistant teachers a \$1,500 a year pay raise beginning with the 2019/2020 school year</i> Due from Governor 4/22
SB2928	Energy High School Academy; authorize Vicksburg-Warren and Claiborne school districts to enter into partnership. Due from Governor 4/20
