SB2050	School enrollment; allow for children with documentation of a parent's pending military relocation to the state. Passed Senate Floor
SB2092	Natchez-Adams Special Municipal Separate School District; elect members of school board. Died
SB2447	Career and technical grants to schools for qualified students; provide for. Passed Senate Floor
SB2449	Education of students in juvenile detention facilities; define responsibility of home school district. Passed Senate Floor
SB2482	Teacher and administrator licenses; clarify grounds for disciplinary action and reinstatement. Died
SB2505	Teacher Forgivable Loan Program; available to nontraditional licensed teachers under certain conditions. Passed Senate Floor
SB2625	Mississippi School of the Arts; provide for administration and clarify employee hiring procedures. Passed Senate Floor
SB2675	Education Scholarship Account (ESA) program; revise. Passed Senate Floor
SB2685	Comprehensive eye examination for students prior to enrollment; require. Passed Senate Floor
SB2770	Teachers' salaries; provide for \$1,000.00 increase phased in over two years. Passed Senate Floor
SB2866	Districts of Innovation; require SDE to recognize use of Cambridge Assessment for purposes of accountability rating. Died

SB2097	Educational expenses at qualified private schools; individual income tax credits for. Died
SB2173	"Mississippi Educational Improvement Tax Credit Act of 2019"; establish. Died
SB2250	Income tax; authorize credit for expenditures for participation of a child in a private education program. Died
SB2456	Ad valorem tax; exempt one vehicle per teacher in shortage areas, and discount tax on one vehicle per teacher in other areas. Died
