Thursday, February 14th, was the deadline for passage of general bills and constitutional amendments originating in each chamber.

The House passed 17 education bills and one Ways and Means bill, which will now go to the Senate to be considered. Five bills died on the calendar.

The Senate passed 8 education bills and one appropriations bill, which will now go to the House to be considered. Three bills died on the calendar.

**The next deadlines for legislation are:**

Wednesday, February 27, 2019	Deadline for original floor action on appropriations and revenue bills originating in their own house.
Tuesday, March 5, 2019	Deadline for committees to report general bills and constitutional amendments originating in the other house.
