CELEBRATION IDEAS

Plan a few special activities during **School Board Member Recognition Week** that will show your board members how much you appreciate them. The February board meeting is an ideal time for a special presentation. Have students, teachers, and staff participate in the celebration. Don't forget to reach out to community members – business partners, civic organizations, or elected officials. Finally, invite the media to cover your activities as an outreach to the community.

Use the following ideas to promote your appreciation efforts. If possible, designate one person to coordinate events with administration, staff, teachers, and community groups. Be sure tips and other information are shared with each school.



In schools:

- Bring board members to classrooms where they can talk to students about board service.
- Recognize board members at sporting events.
- Have students present board members with certificates of appreciation, art work, flowers or fruit baskets at a reception or after a meeting.
- Have students interview and profile board members.
- Encourage parent organizations and student councils to sponsor an appreciation breakfast for the school board.
- Use school marquees and message boards to thank board members for their service.
- Print a copy of the proclamation of School Board Recognition Week in district newsletters.
- Write a personal letter saluting board members to be published in district newsletters and local newspapers.
- Create individual plaques with school board members' names and number of years of service.
- Express written appreciation to board members' families and spouses for supporting them while they volunteer their time on the board.

In the news:

- Send a news release.
 - Ask local newspapers and student newspapers to profile board members.
 - Ask each board member why they serve and use their quotes in news releases and articles.
 - Submit a guest column, letter to the editor, or opinion piece to your local newspaper or online news blog about the job your board members do.
 - Provide news outlets with information about school boards and their special role in local governance of public schools. Be sure to provide a summary of the board's recent outstanding achievements.
 - Ask local newspapers to print an ad thanking school board members in the paper during the week of **February 16-20, 2026**.
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In communities:

- Plan a special reception at your regular board meeting. Invite school board members, students, community members, media, local service groups, etc.
- Display board appreciation posters, cards, and banners in community businesses.
- Ask local merchants to use their marquees to say "School Board Members Inspire Team Leadership."
- Host a reception for school board members prior to a regularly scheduled board meeting.
- Invite former board members to a current school board meeting and recognize them.
- Ask board members' employers and civic groups to recognize them for the job they do through letters, emails, announcements, or newsletters.
- Ask board members' employers to sponsor advertisements recognizing their employee for their community service.
- Ask the PTA to recognize and help spread the word about School Board Recognition Week.
- Create social media posts to recognize the work of School Board Members in your community.
- If your district has a Facebook Page, update your cover photo with the School Board Recognition Week Banner.
